ROMANCE CAPTURED ON FILM AND WITHIN

The Intertwined Narratives of Her and Lost in Translation



As long as films have been around, so has the romance that's been captured in them. As far back as the 1890s, the very beginnings of film technology, the romantic tendencies of humans have been caught on film. Back in 1896's "The May Irwin Kiss" which, due to the ankle hiding tendencies of the time, featured the incredibly taboo practice of cuddling. As time has evolved, this romance has evolved to into intricate and heart-breaking stories, into cinema classics known the world over such as "Casablanca", "The Notebook" and many others. There are two specific films worth discussing in further detail. Due to their production, their very creation is intertwined so heavily. Both are standout modern classics as result of that; the messages in them, by who had written their scripts. These two films are "Her" and "Lost in Translation", and their creators Spike Jonze and Sofia Coppola, ex-husband and wife.

The two films revolve around a central theme of forbidden love, a tired trope, but repurposed to describe the real circumstances around the dual director's break up. "Her" follows a man in a near-future world

that is familiar to us as the viewer, but different enough to always cause an odd sense of unease. This man (Joaquin Phoenix) is lonely, recently out of a bad relationship, in a world that is harsh in coat of paint that pretends to be friendly. Going from date to date, he tries to immediately settle down and fix himself with a relationship anchor. He finally finds comfort in a new, human-like AI with no ulterior motives; an AI with a purpose solely of being a companion. As the movie progresses and the two characters, in this odd and ill-fitting companionship, are developed and become connected, they grow further apart until a rift between them is eventually planted and they separate in a deeply sad, but mutual understanding break. The pair



could truly never work together. The ending leaves you with a bittersweet feeling in the literal sense of the word. The audience is robbed of the typical romance ending, the happy ever after, instead supplanted by this mutual understanding leaving you with the bitterness. However, you are still happy for the characters despite the ending, you still are pleased for them in finding a piece in life just without each other in it.

As it should be obvious at this point, "Lost in Translation" follows a similar path, not in writing but largely in story beats. The film follows another lead (Scarlett Johansson) in a foreign land, this time an American woman stuck in metropolitan Tokyo in an unloving relationship. Like "Her", the world she inhabits pretends to be pleasant, catering to her every need as she stays in an upscale hotel, but yet still cold where the workers are only there to please and not to offer genuine human connection. The other lead in the movie (Bill Murray) is similarly stuck in this awkward position of uncomfortable limbo, awaiting his time to finish shooting a commercial in the country before leaving back to an uncomfortable life in the United States. The two fall into

a position of love and understanding of one another but soon discover that they are clearly incompatible people and their current and existing lives prevent anything further between them.

It is obvious and apparent at this point just how these two films are similar to one another, one from a man's perspective, and one from a woman's. Clearly, Scarlett Johansson is an insert for Coppola and that Joaquin Phoenix

is an insert for Jonze. These two movies detail their own perspectives to one another. This idea of stranger in a strange land exists both within "Lost in Translation" with its brutally true depiction of modern-day Japan, along with "Her" in its near-future disconnect from an exaggerated, modern internet isolationism affect. When considering the reality of the films, it is semi obvious that is in reference to the isolationism of both Hollywood and the nature of relationships in general; pushing one into isolation while still being so ever connected. It needs to be said that of course, this is not the case for all relationships and that many can grow and weave together like holly and ivy. The directors are aware of this fact; that is the true message of the movie, that mutual understanding present in both endings. The type of loving that neither film can provide to itself is a lesson that it is indeed possible if one respects and understands the other. At times, it becomes paramount to be able to recognize the needs of the other, your partner, and also know when their needs are not being met. The best course of action for both parties is a (say it with me now), mutual understanding.

These films offer us a beautifully tragic look into Coppola and Jonze's failed relationship, but also a method to better our own relationships, where we as humans often fail; to fail to get to know our partners and to work to serve the needs of one another. It is very 'me' to use a quote by Marx in an article about romance movies, "To each, according to their own" and I truly believe that Coppola and Jonze understood that both could not fulfill this.

Ingredients:



To preface, it's me, I'm the dummy. Here's a list of information I wish I knew before I started using these programs/starting a project with them.

Revit:


-Adding families: you don't need to add families from outside of revit, unless you need something really



specific. Go to insert -> load autodesk family, and you'll be able to see built in graphics, annotations, etc.
-Moving images/plans on a sheet. You can use your keyboard arrows to adjust the positioning rather than dragging
-No professor will teach you this program. I hate it, I think it's garbage, but it gets used in the real world unfortunately.

Rhino:

-Make shortcuts! Makes it easy to work. (L, for line, etc)
-After extrude make sure to cap your objects, especially if you need to boolean anything
-Blender rendering takes forever, and it's pretty trial and error at the start to see if you have the right brightness



setting and shading.

-Use layers! Very important when keeping organized, especially if you need to move things around
-A lot more type functions than you think! Such as ChangeLayer, -BringToFront/BringForward, Import (for images), etc
-Sun settings can be stinky, but you can change your location, time of year, and time of day to show accurate lighting depending on where your site is. You can also adjust strength of the sun for rendering purposes
Save frequently, this bitch loves to crash at the most inconvenient times

Photoshop:

-Name your layers
-Blending modes can make renders look more realistic and have more depth
-Image -> adjustments to edit pictures

-Selecting inverse after using the marquee or lasso tool are great when removing large elements
-Tbh i don't know how to use clipping layers, if i've made it this far without using them you should be fine. They may make things go faster editing wise but i don't understand them.


Illustrator:

-Stoke adjustments: they moved the spot where you can change these. Properties -> Stroke (you have to click on the text), then you can change the cap, cap, corner, align, dash, and arrowheads.
-Shape not attached? Left click the shaper tool and select the join tool, circle/highlight the disconnected spots to make it a connected shape
-Artboard: to adjust your page size, you can either drag the shape to size or use the page size presets.




HOW TO FIND LOVE IN THE ANIMAL KINGDOM

Howdy folks, as your local biology major, I've taken a lot of classes about animals. From an evolutionary perspective, an organism's only purpose is to reproduce and pass on their DNA. However, inter- and intra-species competition makes it so animals have to compete for mating rights, so evolution has had to get very creative with how one attracts a mate. Since you bitchless engineers have only recently discovered showering, I figured we should take a look at some of our distant relatives to see how they attract a mate in hopes that their methods may work out for you :)

First off, let's define some terms. You've probably heard of the phrase "survival of the fittest" before and assume that only the most physically fit and alpha of animals survive. 
Birds of Paradise

Getting bitches. Males will perform elaborate dances/courtship displays, shaking their feathers and flashing bright colours to attract a female. The flashy colours are a marker of quality males with access to better food supplies will develop brighter coloured feathers. The duration and intensity of the courting dance is an indicator of the male's physical characteristics as well as the male's calls during the dance. Essentially, the more resources a male can put towards exaggerated traits and mating rituals, the more success they will have. These signals can't easily be faked without incurring significant costs to the faker, so they're also seen as "honest signals". So to attract a mate like a bird of paradise, all you need is a bunch of colourful feathers, an elaborate interpretive dance, and no sense of shame.

Frogs

Oh boy, time for everyone's favourite amphibious Anurans! As the most diverse group of amphibians out there, our funny froggy friends have gotten pretty funky with the way they flex their fecundity. No two frog species take the same approach to mating and unfortunately I don't have time to cover the almost 7000 species of frogs, so let's look at the general approach. The first step in getting bitches is finding bitches. How do you find bitches when



you're a tiny frog in a big pond? Easy, you let them come to you. In most species, males will loudly call from a possible breeding site. Each species has a distinct call and females are able to recognize the call of their own species. In the Wrinkled Toadlet (*Uperoleia rugosa*), heavier males with deeper-pitched calls are deemed the most attractive by females. Once a female has found a male, she'll often evaluate the male's vocal sac. Males inflate their vocal sacs to amplify their mating call, so the shape and size can tell a female about a male's fitness. What if you have no vocal sac? If you're the Goliath frog, you produce a whistling sound to attract a female. I bet you're asking if these calls are honest signals and don't you worry they are! The significant cost incurred by the male in the situation is that vocal signals can attract predators. Sitting for long periods of time trying to attract a mate expends energy and leaves them vulnerable to predators. Therefore, the risks associated with the signal ensures its honesty.

So to attract a mate like a frog, all you need is a vocal sac, some sweet tunes, and a log to sit on.

Mammals

Time for my favourite Class because it's the one I'm in! Let's talk about mammals! There are around 6400 extant species of mammals that have been divided into 29 orders. Again, we don't have the time or space to cover everything so let's go over the broad strokes.

The most common form of attraction used by mammals is pheromones. A pheromone is a secreted or excreted chemical factor that triggers a social

response. They act like hormones outside of the body, affecting the behaviour of the receiving individual(s). Female pheromones tend to indicate the availability of the female for breeding, Male pheromones tend to convey information about their species and genotype. Humans also release pheromones, but their exact function and influence is highly debated. In a lot of animals, urine is the main source of pheromones. For example, male moose will dig pits in the ground called wallows, fill them with their urine, and rub the muddy mixture onto themselves. How appealing! That's not me exaggerating, female moose have been known to fight each other over wallows.

Plenty of animals fight for mating rights too. Horned animals will use said horns to fight each other and potentially kill their rival. As with any species, fish have unique reproductive organs and mating techniques which are adapted to their environment and specialised to each species. The classic pattern is of male and female fish gathering at spawning grounds, females lay their eggs directly into the water or settlement, and males release their sperm to fertilise the eggs. There isn't much sexual selection at play here as these large populations just sorta aim to make as many offspring as possible in hopes that some survive. Not all species act like this though.

Japanese puffer fish (within the genus Takifugu) create beautiful and elaborate underwater artwork to attract the attention of a female.

It consists of a pattern of circles on the seabed, similar to crop circles. Males draw this pattern with their fins, pushing sand away, and working relentlessly for around a week. The perfectly geometric pattern measures around 2 metres in diameter and can have complex patterns composed of lines, valleys, and ridges. Some even add shells or coloured rocks to add to their art.

The drummer fish (*Aplodinotus grunniens*) produces grunting and rumbling sounds to attract a mate. Seahorses perform long dances which include caresses, hugs, and colour changes. These dances can last up to 8 hours and are used to strengthen their bond. Anglerfish is where shit gets really weird! Males secrete a pheromone and females will aid their

search by flashing their lure. Once a male finds a suitable mate, he bites into her belly and latches on until his body fuses with hers. Their skin and blood vessels join together which allows the male to take all the nutrients he needs from his mate. 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
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
